

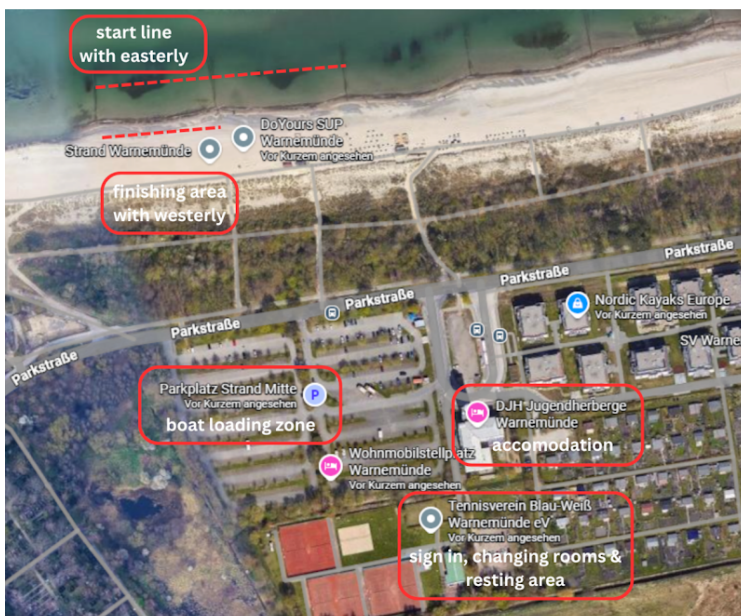
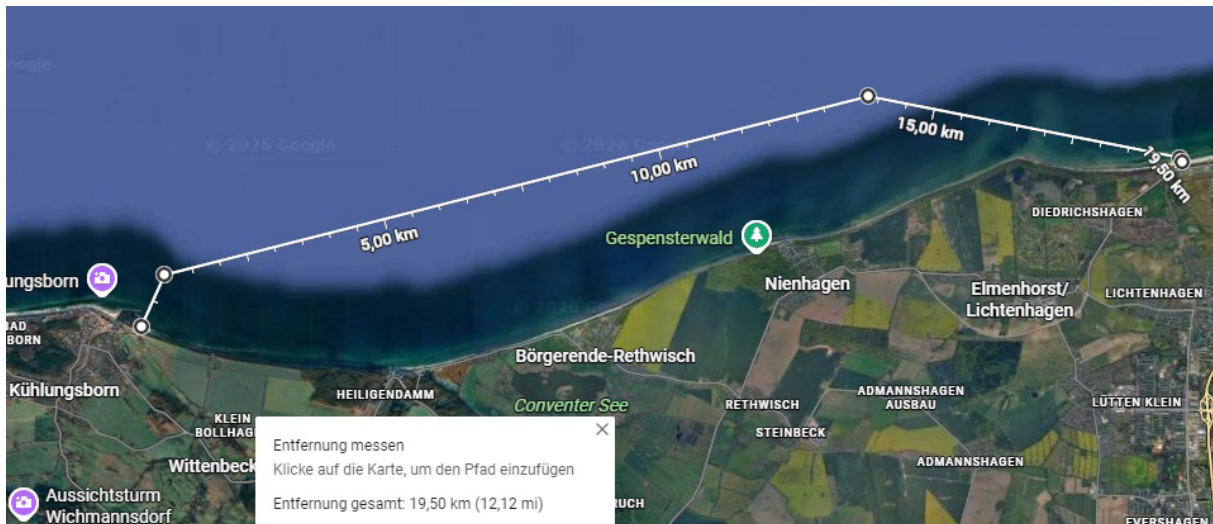
Bulletin - 14th OC Ostseecup

Dear athletes,
It's finally time! We invite you to our race on the Baltic Sea.

When Sunday, July 19, 2026

Where Beach area (Beach access 25)
Parking lot: Parkstraße 51-53, 18119 Rostock-Warnemünde

Course The planned course is a downwind run from Kühlungsborn to Warnemünde. Alternatively, the course will run in the opposite direction from Warnemünde to Kühlungsborn, or, if there is insufficient wind, a 15-18 km triangular course will be offered in front of beach access 25 in Warnemünde.

 The online registration is open until July 12, 2026.
 The exact schedule will be announced approximately 2-4 days before the race. The meeting point and bib number distribution will be at the [Blau-Weiß Warnemünde Tennis Club](#) (Parkstraße 48, 18119 Rostock).
 We must limit the number of participants to 170 athletes

- Entry Fee:** Entry fees are per person. An early bird discount is available in the first month. Registration on the day of the competition is possible for an additional fee. A reduced entry fee applies to youth participants (born 2008 and younger) and international athletes (residency outside of Germany).

Shuttle:

We are planning to offer boat and passenger shuttles again. Please indicate in your registration whether you would like to use this service. We will try to reserve as many spaces as possible, but they will eventually be limited.

Accommodation:

Tent camping is available to a limited extent for €10 per person per night on the grounds of the Blau-Weiß Warnemünde Tennis Club. If interested please contact us directly.

Alternatively, we recommend the youth hostel right next door. Please note that the German Championships for lifesaving athletes and a tennis tournament at the tennis club will be taking place in Warnemünde at the same time. Therefore we ask for mutual consideration and fairness during ongoing matches on the grounds of the tennis club.

Safety:

Athletes and their equipment must be race-ready. In particular, each athlete must be able to re-enter the boat unassisted. Participation is at your own risk. By registering, participants confirm that they are able to compete. The race will be supervised by the DLRG. Wearing a **PFD** and a **leash** during the race is **mandatory**. A working **mobile phone in a waterproof case** is also **mandatory**. Failure to comply with the safety regulations will result in immediate disqualification from the competition. It is recommended to use additional safety applications such as Save TRX and to carry an audible (whistle) or visual (flare) signal. Outrigger paddlers are advised to carry a spare paddle. **All athletes are required to assist fellow paddlers in distress**. The time spent assisting will be credited to the person providing assistance (ideally verifiable via GPS watch). Please report to race control after the race.

With entering the race each competitor agrees to the terms and conditions of the race. The organizing team is happy to assist with any questions, requests, or suggestions. For updates and news, please regularly check our website www.kanufreunde.de and the [KFRG Instagram](#) channel.

Terms and Conditions of Participation

1. Only athletes/teams who have registered officially, agreed to the terms and conditions of participation, and paid the entry fee are eligible to participate.
 2. A race class will be scored if at least four boats are registered (excluding Juniors as stated above). The Spec Ski race class will be scored separately as a sub-class within the Surfski category.
 3. The instructions of the organizing staff from KFRG, the German Life Saving Association (DLRG) and the German Red Cross (DRK) must be followed without exception. For safety reasons, the organizer reserves the right to exclude participants who do not follow instructions from the regatta.
 4. Only participants who adhere to the event's safety protocols are eligible to start. At least one athlete per boat must be connected to the boat via a leash for the entire duration of the race. If the start/finish line is on the beach, the leash must be attached/detached within the first/last 100 meters. Wearing a PFD and carrying a working mobile phone is mandatory for all athletes! Failure to comply will result in immediate disqualification. It is recommended to use Save TRX and to carry a flare or whistle. OC paddlers are also advised to carry a spare paddle.
 5. All participants take part in the regatta on July 19, 2026, at their own risk. No liability is assumed for lost or stolen items, or for damage to equipment or persons. It is the responsibility of each participant to assess whether they are up to the conditions on the day of the race.
 6. The use of the shuttle transport is at your own risk. All shuttled participants waive any claims for compensation from the driver and owner of the vehicle for any accident damage, except in cases of intent or gross negligence, as long as this is not covered by insurance. (This applies to both persons and equipment.)
 7. The organizer, sponsors, volunteers, employees, and officials are released from any liability upon completing the registration.
 8. Each participant declares that they are able to swim safely in the race attire worn on the day of the event. By registering, participants confirm that they are physically capable of participating in this regatta. Participants are responsible for their own safety. Furthermore, they confirm that they will adhere to the safety guidelines outlined in the race announcement.
 9. The organizer reserves the right to interrupt or cancel the race in the event of severe weather/thunderstorms or other unforeseen circumstances. Entry fees are non-refundable in such cases. By entering, the participant waives all rights to compensation.
 10. Participants under the age of 18 are required to submit a signed consent form from their parents or legal guardian(s) with their registration documents. A form is provided at the following [link](#) which has to be filled out and send to info@kanufreunde.de.
 11. During the race, participants must expect crossing recreational boat and ship traffic. The rules of the sea and shipping regulations must be observed.
- 12. Right to one's own image:** In accordance with the exception clause of Section 23 Paragraph 1 No. 3 of the German Copyright Act (KUG) regarding the right to one's own image, photographs may be taken and published at sporting events without requiring the permission of the individuals depicted. By participating in the aforementioned event, each participant agrees to this procedure. Each participant consents to the publication of their name in the registration and results list on the organizer's website. This consent can be revoked at any time.
